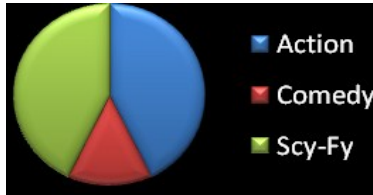


Fourth Grade
